2017 was a key year for **FindMeCure Foundation** as we were focused on understanding better patient's anxieties, pains and needs in order to address them within our work.

We have interviewed hundreds of **patients** both online and on spot and aimed to get the perspective of patients with different profiles - young and adult, patients with chronic or lifethreatening diseases, patients with no or extensive knowledge about clinical trials.

We have also interviewed a variety of **health professionals** worldwide - GPs, specialists and investigators participating in clinical trials. The aim was to also explore their pains and difficulties as regards to their communication with patients as well as their challenges during the patient recruitment process.

FindMeCure conducted an interview with a patient with Complex Regional Pain Syndrome (CRPS) who was not satisfied with current treatments and was looking for an alternative in the face of clinical trials at FindMeCure. The interview was included in a <u>blog article</u> which was published and disseminated through our channels.

Our partners at the International Alliance of Patient Organizations (IAPO) commemorate the *Patient Solidarity Day* each December. This year's theme was:

'Patient Empowerment through knowledge'. Find-MeCure took part in the campaign through conducting a webinar on "Where are all the new treatments and how to benefit from them" The webinar was attended by around 30 patients and representatives of patient organizations world-wide. This was a first step of a series of webinars that the Foundation will develop for patients in 2018 and ahead.

The seminars were held in Plovdiv (30.09.2017) and Sofia (04.10.2017) and brought together patients, medical specialists and industry. A representative of FindMeCure presented about clinical trials as a treatment option and how new technologies like this platform can help patients find all ongoing studies on one place and join the most suitable one.

The meeting was focused on discussing the priorities within the new presidency of EFPIA on behalf of the pharmaceutical company Merck, one of which is patient recruitment for clinical trials.

FindMeCure platform was presented as a bestpractice platform for patient recruitment which provides patient-friendly information on all clinical trials worldwide and helps patients to apply for participation for the most suitable one for them.


